Working field: Within the framework of the project SpreeWasser:N, which is funded by the BMBF and coordinated by the Hydrogeology Group of the TU Berlin, the influence of climate change and land use changes on water resources in SE Brandenburg is analyzed. The aim is to develop suitable adaptation measures and early warning systems for water stress conditions and to evaluate their efficiency. In addition to 8 scientific partners (such as FU Berlin, PIK, ZALF, BfG, University of Trier), two industrial partners, numerous water suppliers and over 20 stakeholders from the Berlin-Brandenburg region are involved in the research project.
